

I am currently carrying 2 types of vinyl. This chart will hopefully clarify the differences between the two types I carry in my store.

	Glitter Vinyl	Glistening Sparkle Vinyl or Mirror Vinyl

To sum it up:

Both vinyl products are very easy to use and work extremely well with an embroidery machine. You can use a standard embroidery needle with either of the products and I usually don't change my needle until I've noticed breaking of the thread. Then I know it's time for a new one.

There are a few differences between the two vinyl products. The Glitter Vinyl is much thicker and heavier then the Glisten Sparkle/Mirror vinyl. I would recommend using this one for Free Standing pieces like Bows and Glam Bands. It holds the shape better. The glisten vinyl/Mirror Vinyl cuts easier because it's much thinner, it also is much shinier then the Glitter Vinyl. I would recommend using this type for appliqués. You could use a heavier stabilizer if you would like to use it for bows, you can try it out and see what you think.

Both are smooth on the top. You will not have any glitter flakes nor does it feel rough to the touch.

I would not recommend using a good pair of scissors when cutting either of these fabrics. It will dull your scissors much quicker than normal. Be sure to get a small sharp pair so you are able to cut through the vinyl easier.

You don't necessarily need to add a backing to either of the vinyl but I do recommend it. Depending on your project, you can make the call.

I sell both vinyl in sheets and rolls. A sheet is 9x12" and a roll has 6 sheets and is 12x54". 98% of the time if you order more than I sheet it will come in a continuous roll. If you see the inventory of at least 6 or more if you order 6 sheets you will get I roll. IF I'm not able to provide a continuous roll I will email you and let you know.
